We celebrate the start of our 2019/20 season with Bartók's virtuosic Concerto for Orchestra, in which every instrument gets a moment in the spotlight. Webern's *Passacaglia* was the piece that launched his career: a fond farewell to the nineteenth century and to the music of Brahms, as well as a foretaste of the radical ideas he was about to pursue.
